- SIGN-UPS: For General Assistance (GA), Medi-Cal, Food Stamps.
- EMPLOYMENT: Jobs and job training. Other employment opportunities.
- SUPERIOR COURT HOMELESS & CARING COURT: Informational meeting
- CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES: Develop an individual care plan.
- WINTER SHELTER: Sign-ups and transportation to Oakland Army Base.
- HOUSING: Transitional and permanent housing referrals + drug and alcohol treatment programs.
- DISABLED CARE: Wheelchair repair + Center for Independent Living

All services are free of charge. Bag lunches available from 10:45 AM to 12:45 PM.
