- **MEDICAL CARE:** Acute medical care + referrals for chronic medical and psychological care.
- **SAME DAY SERVICES:** Winter clothing, hygiene kits, nutrition packages, haircuts, massage, bag lunch.
- **SIGN-UPS:** For General Assistance (GA), Medi-Cal, Food Stamps.
- **EMPLOYMENT:** Jobs and job training. Other employment opportunities.
- **SUPERIOR COURT HOMELESS & CARING COURT:** Informational meeting
- **CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES:** Develop an individual care plan.
- **WINTER SHELTER:** Sign-ups and transportation to Oakland Army Base.
- **HOUSING:** Transitional and permanent housing referrals + drug and alcohol treatment programs.
- **DISABLED CARE:** Wheelchair repair + Center for Independent Living

All services are free of charge. Bag lunches available from 10:45 AM to 12:45 PM.
